July 19-30, 2010

July 19th - Arrive at Kilimanjaro Airport - Arusha Tanzania

July 19- 26 - 8 nights at Moivaro Coffee Plantation Lodge

Make a unique connection to the lives of the people of Tanzania in our partner communities and villages. Also included is a ranger-guided wildlife hike in Arusha National Park.

July 27th - Wildlife safari to Tarangire National Park - Overnight at Tarangire Safari Lodge

July 28th - Wildlife safari to Lake Manyara - overnight at Kirurumu Tent Camp

July 29th - Wildlife safari to Ngorongoro Crater - overnight at Kirurumu Tent Camp

July 30th - Return to Arusha for afternoon goodbyes - evening departure from Kilimanjaro Airport

July 13-19, 2010**

At Entebbe, Uganda, overnight at the lovely Boma Guest House. The next day, we fly to beautiful and mountainous southwest Uganda. Visit project communities and experience local life for 3 days in Kanungu and Rukungiri Districts. Travel overland enjoying expansive scenes, crossing the equatorial line, and lunching at a local restaurant en route to Entebbe.
