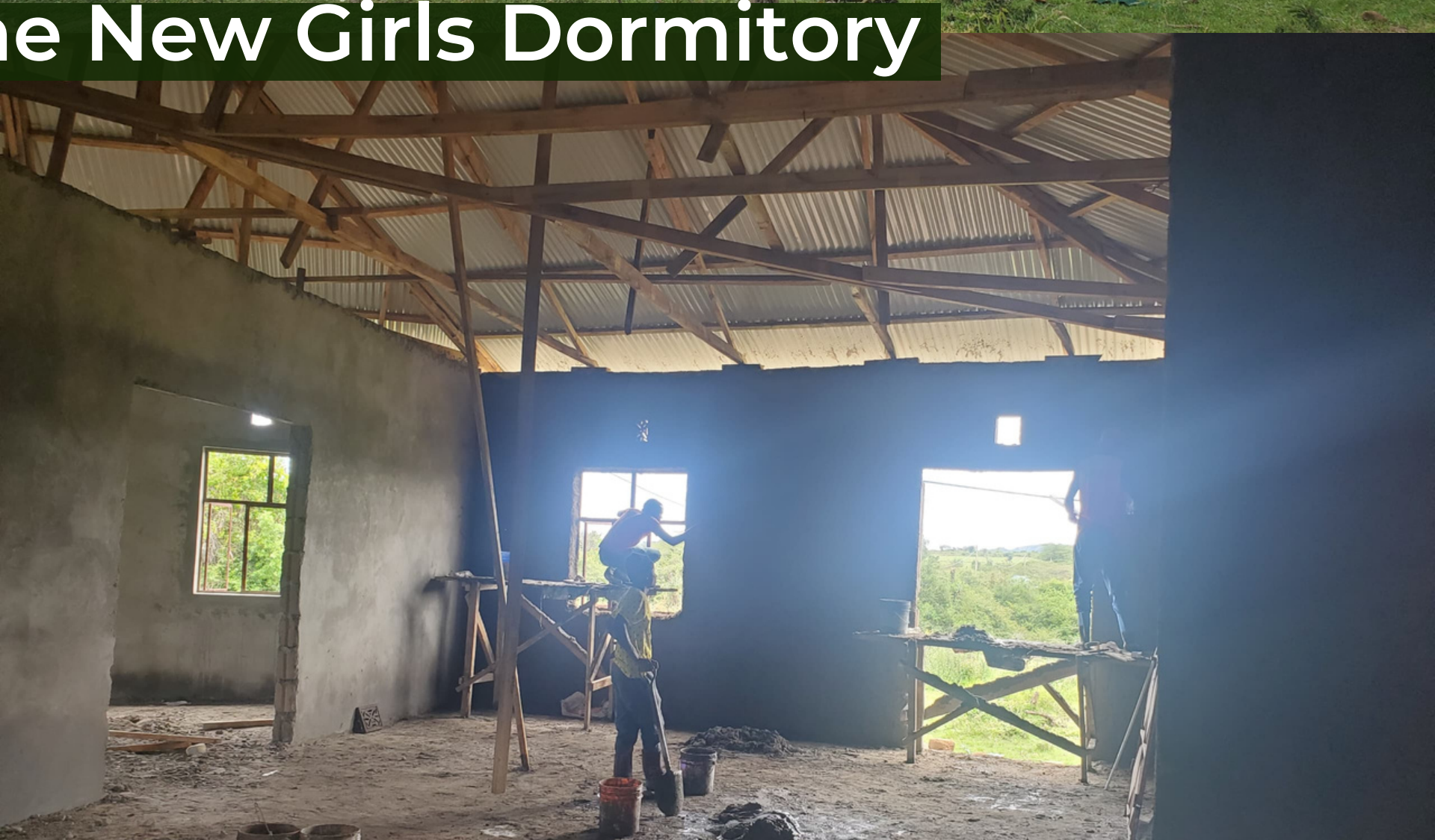

Updated Pictures of the New Girls Dormitory



Construction of 70 Beds

The generous donation of 20,000 USD from Global Partners for the development of Emanyata Secondary School infrastructures has made a significant impact on the ongoing construction of a 200-bed girls' dormitory at Emanyata Secondary School.

This dormitory is a vital and long-overdue project, prompted by a steady increase in female student enrollment over the past four years.

Currently, the school has a total of 293 students, of which 206 are girls. As the dormitory construction approaches completion, our goal is to ensure that every girl has a safe and comfortable place to sleep and thus part of the funds received are being used to produce 70 beds.

Once completed, the dormitory will not only allow us to accommodate more students but will also significantly improve their academic performance, especially for girls who currently face the hardship of traveling long distances to attend school.

Each bed costs approximately 220,000 TSH. To fully furnish the dormitory, a total of 70 beds are needed, coming at a total of 15,400,000 Tanzanian Shillings or 5,727.3004 USD.



New Re-purposed Library

Emanyata Secondary School recently received over 16,000 books that were generously donated by friends in the United States.

These books were sent to us in a container that is now being transformed into a fully functional library for our students. Once finished, this new library will greatly enrich our student's learning experience.

To complete the container transformation, there's a need for some essential items to ensure that students can read and study comfortably, as well as keep the space organized and functional for all, ensuring the sustainability of both the space and books.

The needed items are:

- Sturdy hardwood shelves
- Chairs

This work is currently underway and is expected to be finalized by next week.



Staff Furniture

The following important priority is upgrading the office furniture for our staff members.

Currently, the office is still using outdated furniture from 1992, and with very limited available pieces.

With a total of 24 staff members, 14 of whom are teachers, there is an urgent need for comfortable and functional office furniture, including desks, chairs, and storage units for teaching materials.

A total of 3,500 USD or 9,394,142.00 Tanzanian Shillings, have been allocated to address this urgent need effectively.

Supporting our staff members and ensuring they have a suitable working environment, supports productivity, professionalism, and dedication to the job, all of which contribute to our students well being.



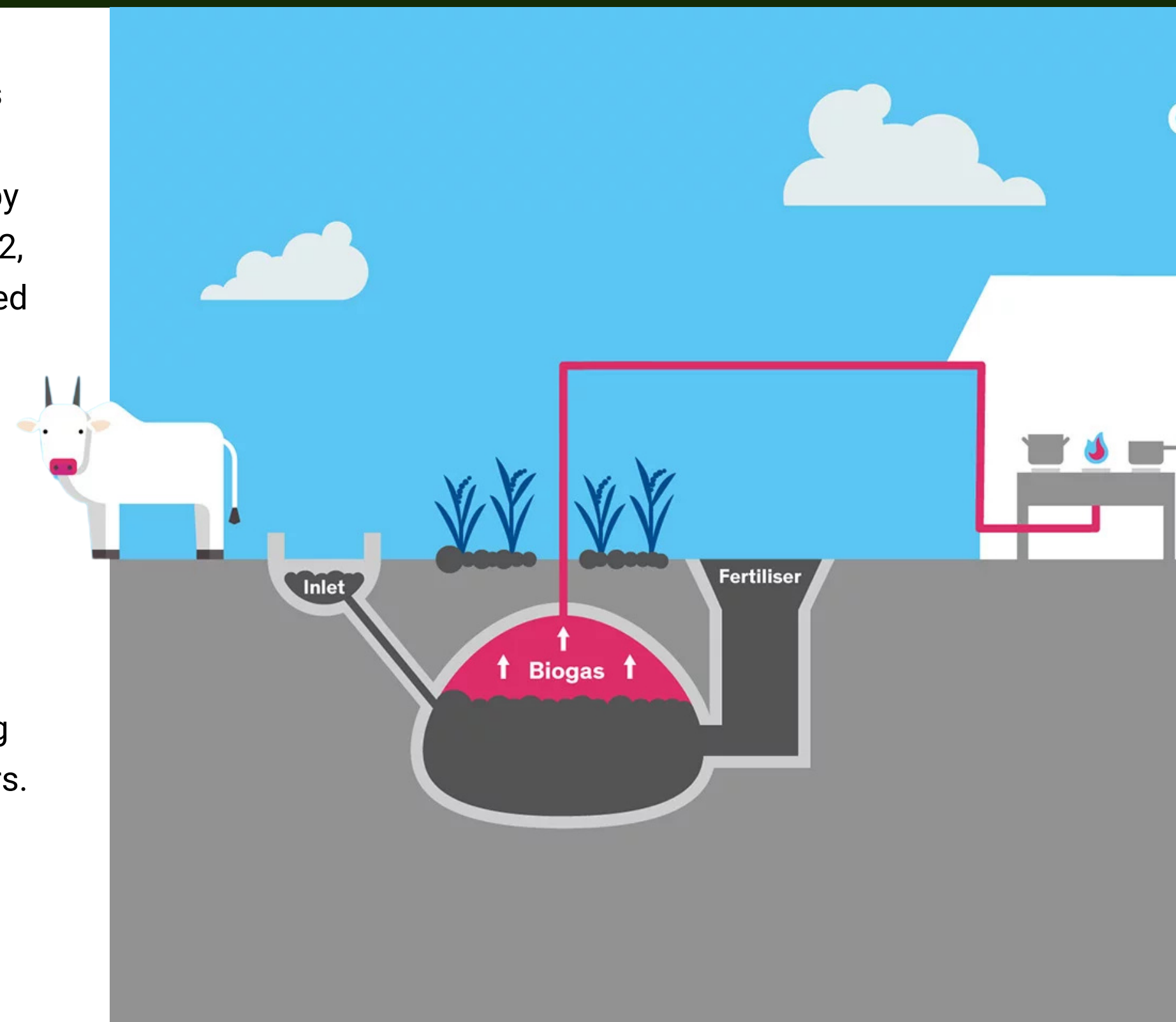
Future Key Priorities to Support

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One of the essential future initiatives we hope Global Partners can support is the installation of a biogas system. Previously, the school relied on firewood collected from nearby allocated land. However, since this land was reclaimed in 2022, both the school and the surrounding community have struggled to access sufficient firewood.

A biogas system would significantly reduce environmental degradation, introduce sustainable energy technology, and provide a long-term solution for cooking meals at Emanyata, a solution that would benefit both the students and the wider community.

A well-constructed biogas unit, capable of cooking for 400 students, costs approximately 50,000 USD. While PWC is actively seeking additional funding from other sources, this project is feasible to implement within 1.5 to 2 years.
